1. Introduction

The SSA Resen managed to organize the first training event for public land owners in the region of Prespa, in Republic of Macedonia. It has been quite successful training event as the first step to introduce the SRC issues to the representatives of the public institutions that have public land in property.

2. Overview of training event

2.1 Summary

The first training has been organized by SSA Resen with a brief summary of the main aspects of SRC for public land owners. Further details follow in the relevant chapter below. This first event was quite successful and a positive feedback was given by the attending participants that are the reference to arrange next / second training event. The attendance of external experts was relatively challenging, since the SRC matters are not yet in progress in Republic of Macedonia. Therefore, the project team made efforts to present the topics as much as better to the participants, using information and materials from the SRCplus project publications.

At the beginning of the training a brief and concise presentations about important issues for public land owners was given (see the detailed agenda in addition). Than the training course continue with the next topics until lunch and session after lunch.

2.2 Feedback from participants

The general feedback has been quite positive, participants could at first get an overview of general and specific information about the SRC, right choice of SRC seedlings, land properties, cultivation and sustainability as well as all the topics mentioned in the agenda.
